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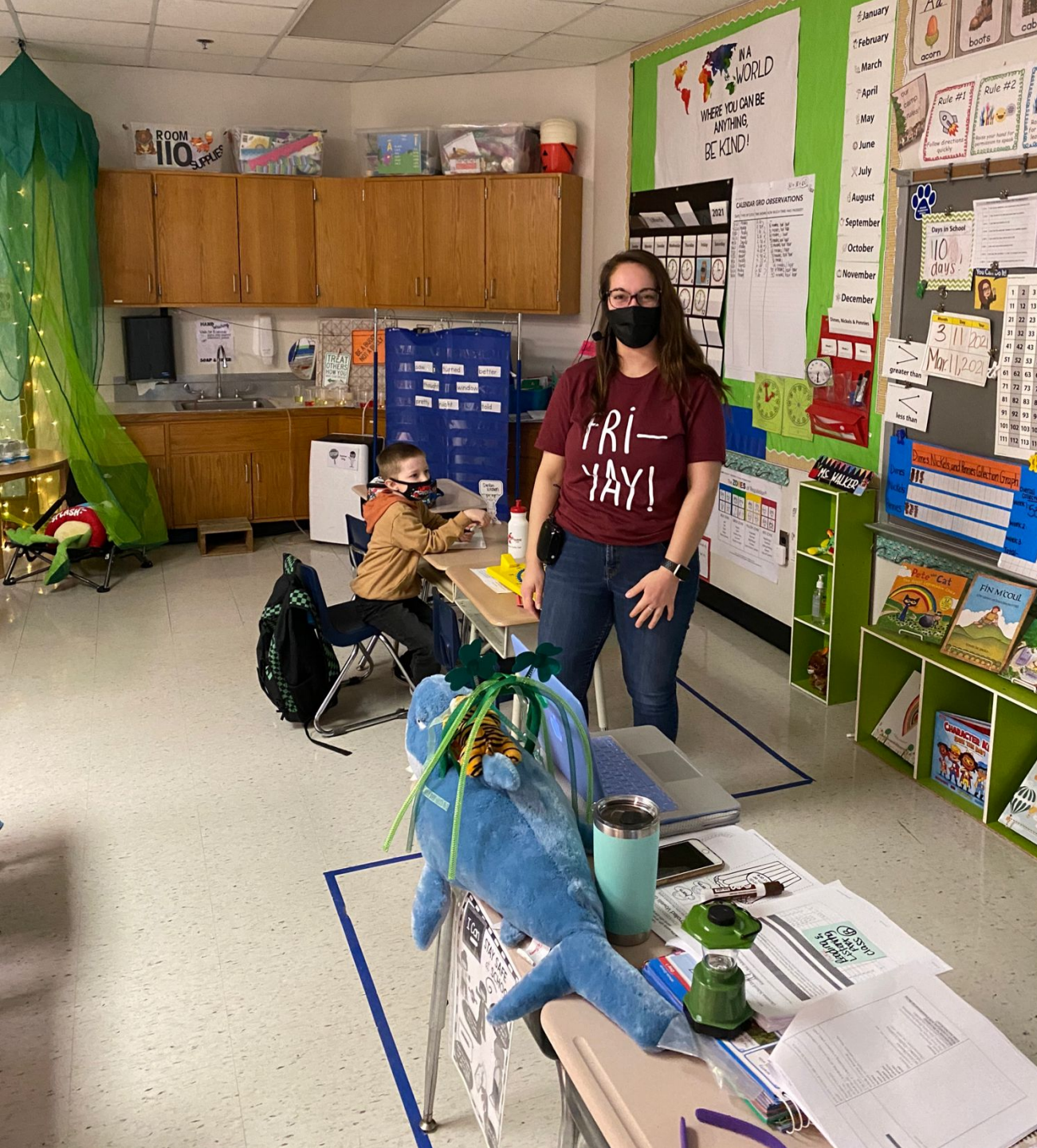

Technology

- Bark for Schools - We have communicated to parents by email inviting them to create and sign up for the Bark Parent Portal to view and receive alerts. So far 40% of our families have created an account.
- Chromebook Cases - We have started to deploy chromebook cases to students
- Teaching and Learning Team is looking into other resources for next year such as dual monitors and newline panels for classrooms. We will also extend our Nearpod online resource for instructional purposes.

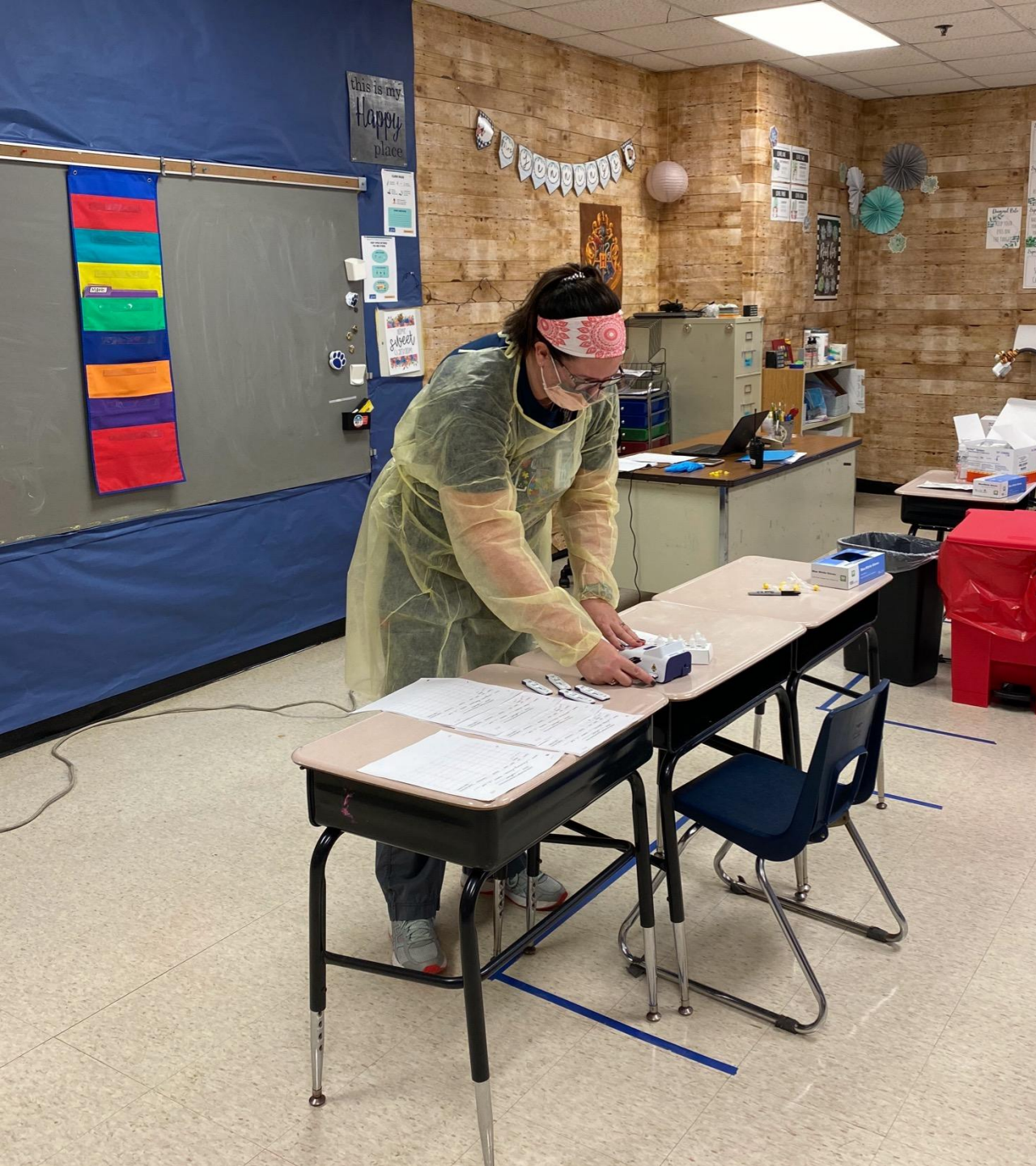
Nutrition

- Providing remote meal access via bus delivery to high-need communities in addition to curbside pickup
 - **21** curbside sites
 - 1 Newark evening curbside site
 - **27** bus stop sites (11 buses in service for meals)
 - In person meal service for Cohort A&B
 - Delivery to classrooms for elementary schools
 - Grab & Go lunch for middle/high schools as students depart
- Curb & Mobile sites provide weekend meals each Friday
- Breakfast and lunch meals are provided for free through 6/30/2021

Operations and Services

Facilities

- Adibots - The seven Adibot UV disinfection robots have been delivered to Eden and will be dispersed this week to their respective schools.
- RFP - Selection for A/E firm for the design and project management to renovate the HVAC systems at several of our schools as part of ESSER II and ESSER III Grant funds.
- Sterionizers - Four of the six, Group II schools have been installed. The remaining two schools will be installed in the next two weeks. We are finalizing the design and proposals for the next 9 schools (Group III).

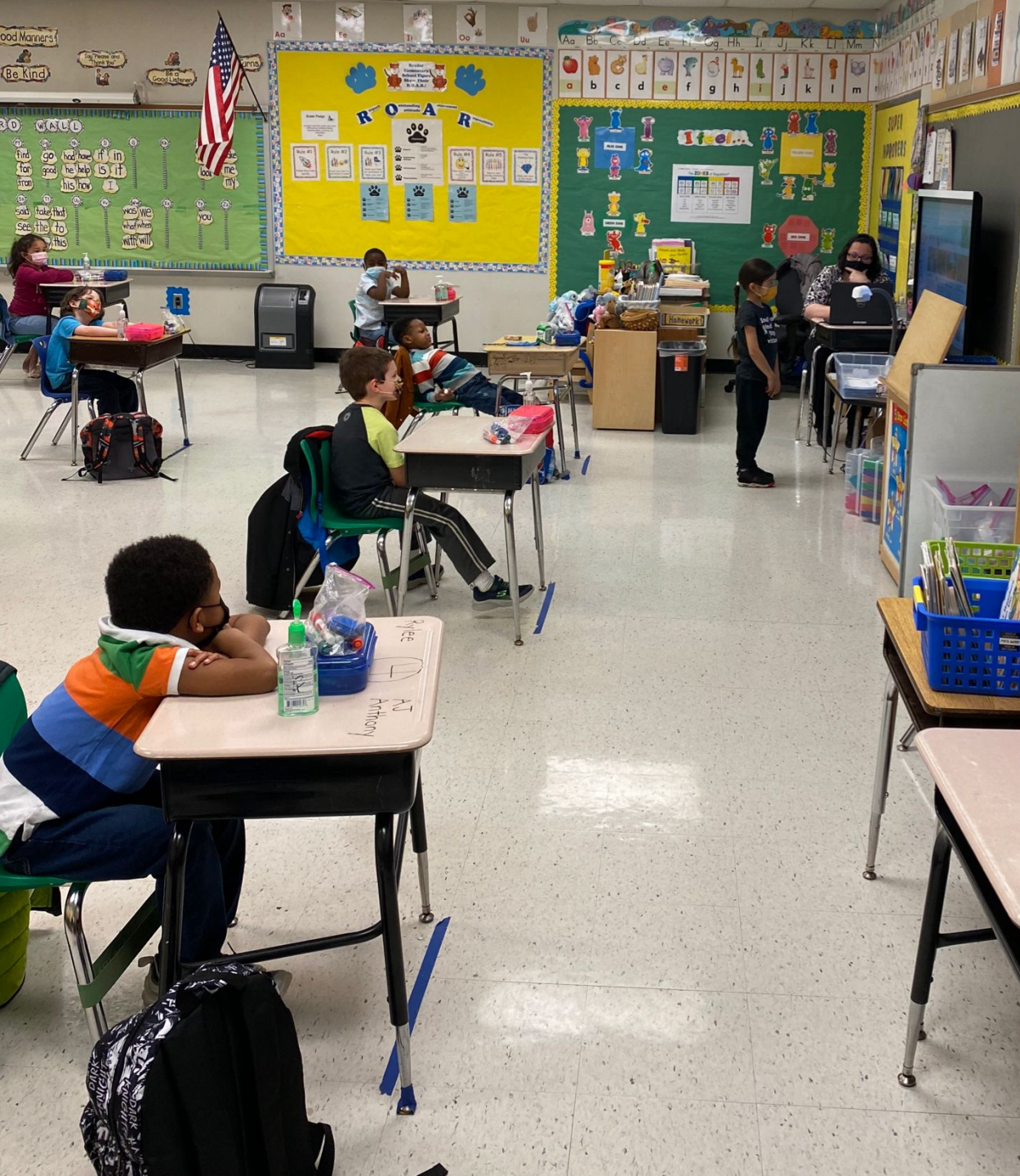

- Persons 16 & 17 years old are only eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine – check the vaccine being offered at each site closely.

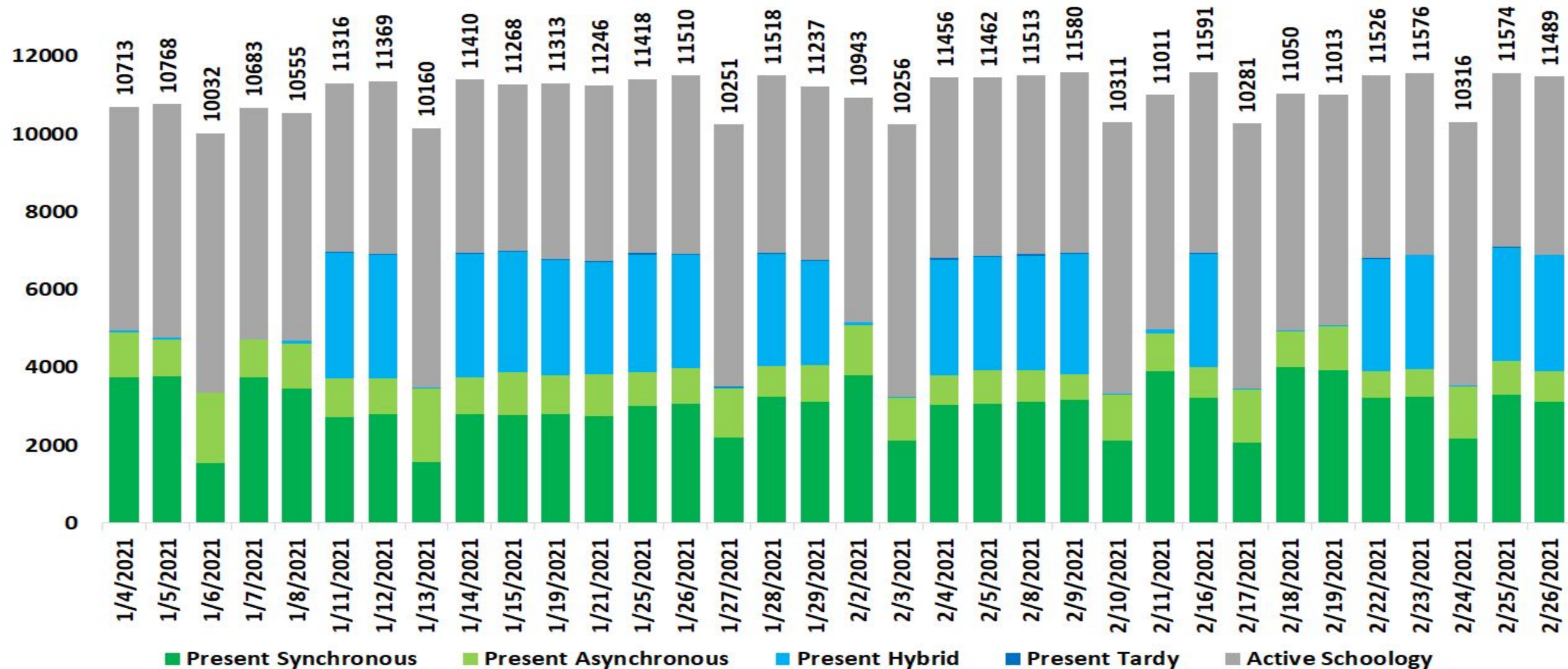

Additional Learning Time/Opportunities

- Extending the school week by moving to a full instructional “remote” day for all students.
- Offering additional learning time to families based on prioritized need:
 - Students with Disabilities
 - Students with Accommodation Plans
 - Students in need of academic support
 - Young Learners (K-2)
 - Currently 1972 students have been moved to Cohort C for additional learning time.
 - Currently 3820 students are enrolled in the CSD Virtual Academy.

Instructional Support

- After-school programming to provide academic support, tutoring and enrichment opportunities.
- Course and Credit Recovery programming, including partnership with Adult Education
- Private tutoring slots shared across our district
- FAME and Upward Bound registration and programming continues, which includes additional tutoring opportunities.
- Continuing to offer office hours for families and students to connect with their teachers.

Instruction Support for Home

- Curriculum Maps for Reading and Math will be posted to a dedicated landing page on our district website for elementary and secondary students
- Syllabi for electives and unique courses will be posted to Schoology for all secondary students.
- Families will find a scope and sequence to use as they facilitate instruction at home.

Special Populations Update

- All buildings have continued to increase in-person learning opportunities while still maintaining the COVID safety protocols outlined by CSD, DPH and CDC guidelines

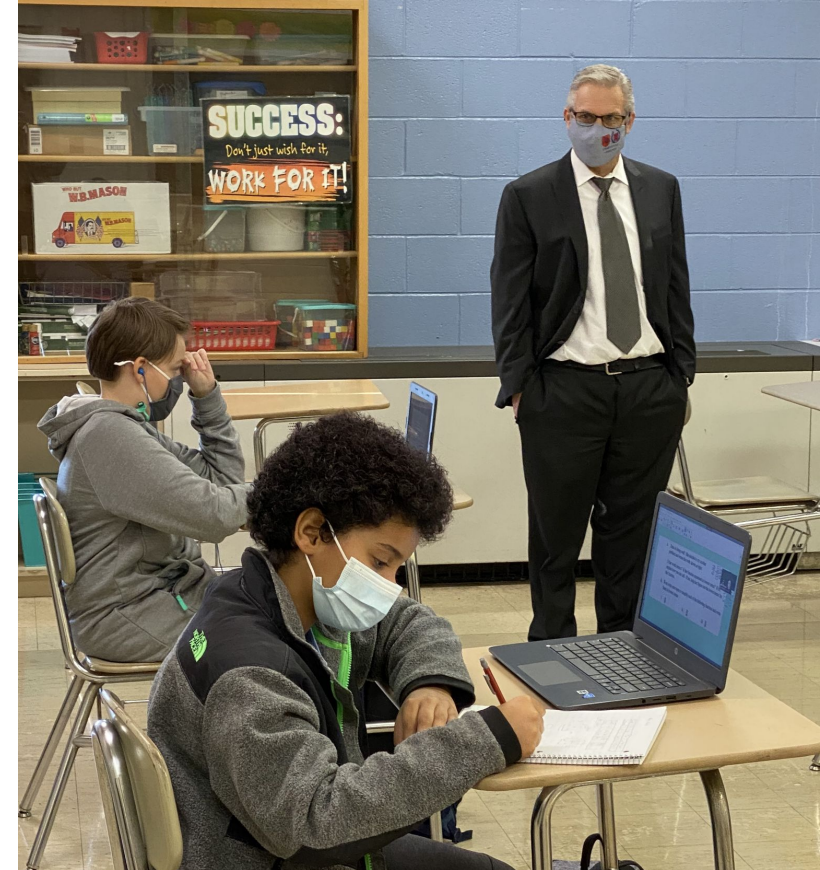
