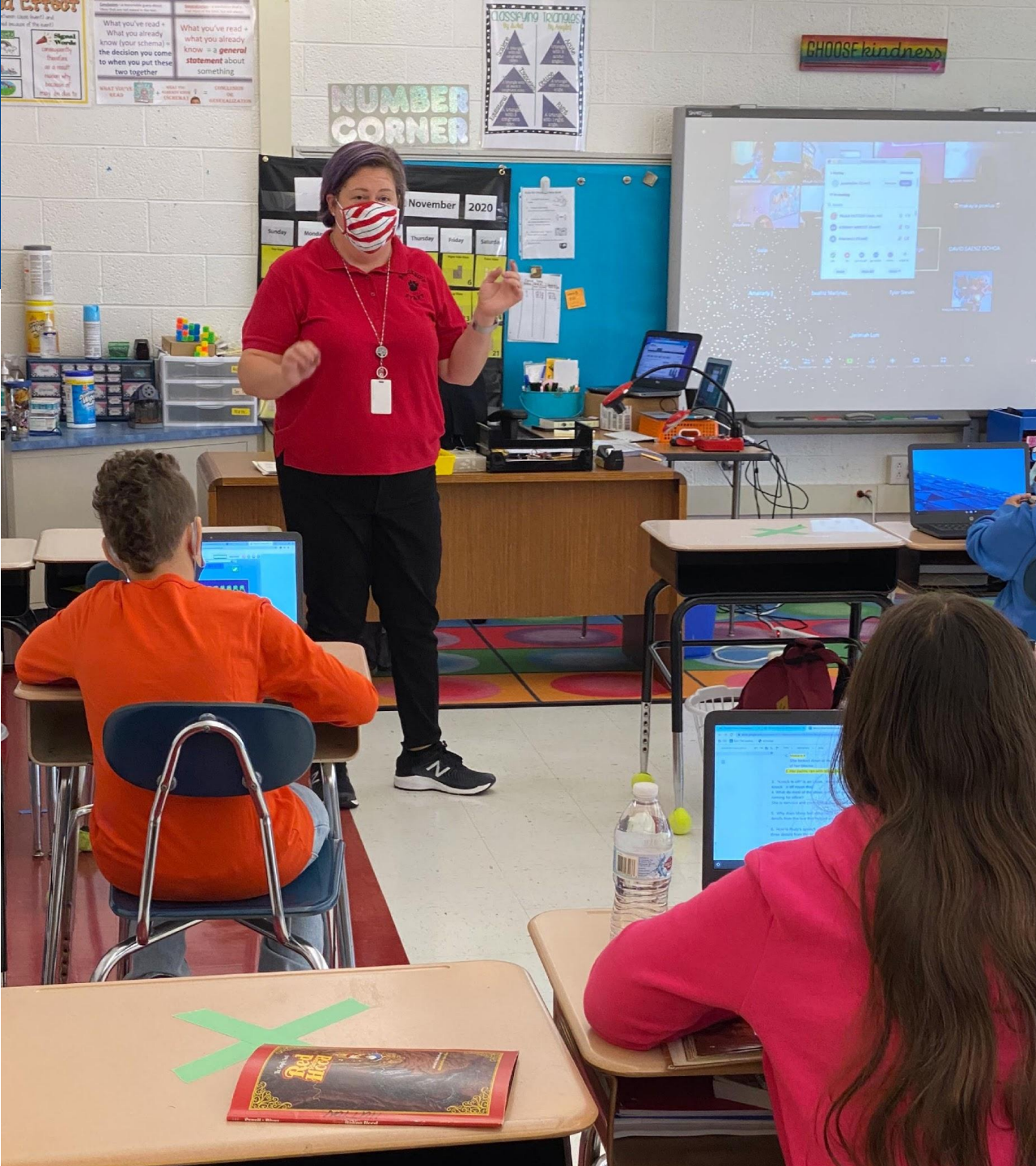

Operations and Services

Technology

- We continue to deploy devices and hotspots as needed at our schools
- **Nearpod** (a program to make lessons more interactive): we have trained our curriculum specialists and instructional coaches. The next group to receive training will be our technology coordinators (in each building) to act as the Nearpod Champions to offer support and strategies for teachers.
- We are in the third week of implementing **Bark for Schools**, our Chromebook monitoring service for students to identify and alert school teams of potential problems

Operations and Services

Nutrition

- Providing remote meal access via bus delivery to high-need communities in addition to curbside pickup
 - **21** curbside sites
 - 1 Newark evening curbside site
 - **27** bus stop sites (11 buses in service for meals)
 - In person meal service for Cohort A&B
 - Delivery to classrooms for elementary schools
 - Grab & Go lunch for middle/high schools as students depart
- Breakfast and lunch meals are provided for free through 6/30/2021

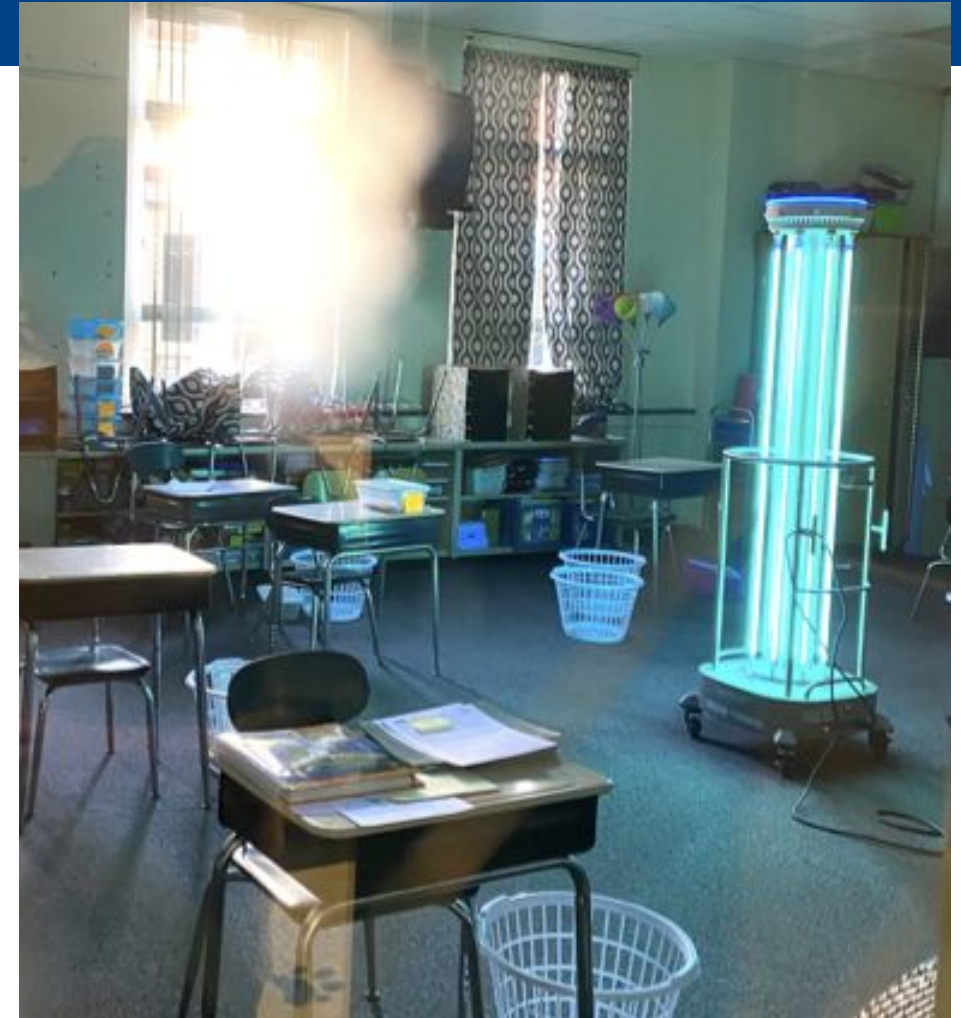
Operations and Services

Facilities

- PPE - Inventory Accounting Document is updated weekly by the Chief Custodians.
- HVAC - District HVAC System Report is being updated monthly.
- Strategies for Minimizing the Spread of the Virus
 - Verified the correct operation of the Sterionizers at Brennen through the use of an ion meter.
 - Working through the design and installation schedule for the next 10 schools for the Sterionizer installations.

ADIBOT: Innovative Disinfection System

- Christina School District first organization in the world to test the cutting edge robot.
- Two week pilot program at Bancroft and Bayard
- UV-C light destroys germs on every surface quickly and effectively without the use of chemicals
- Provides faster turnaround on environments exposed to a positive COVID case. Technology allows room to be safe almost immediately
- Custodial staff response positive and higher comfort level going into room after the ADIBOT

 - February Testing Dates - 10th, 24th
 - 2/10 - Kirk Middle School - (12 - 6PM)
- Antigen (christinak12.org/Page/4937)
 - COVID-19 Testing for hybrid learners and staff.
 - Started Pilot on January 19th at Gallaher Elementary
 - As of Feb. 8th: Pilot + 6 Days of Testing
 - 336 Students, 129 Staff = 465 Tests
 - 1 Positive

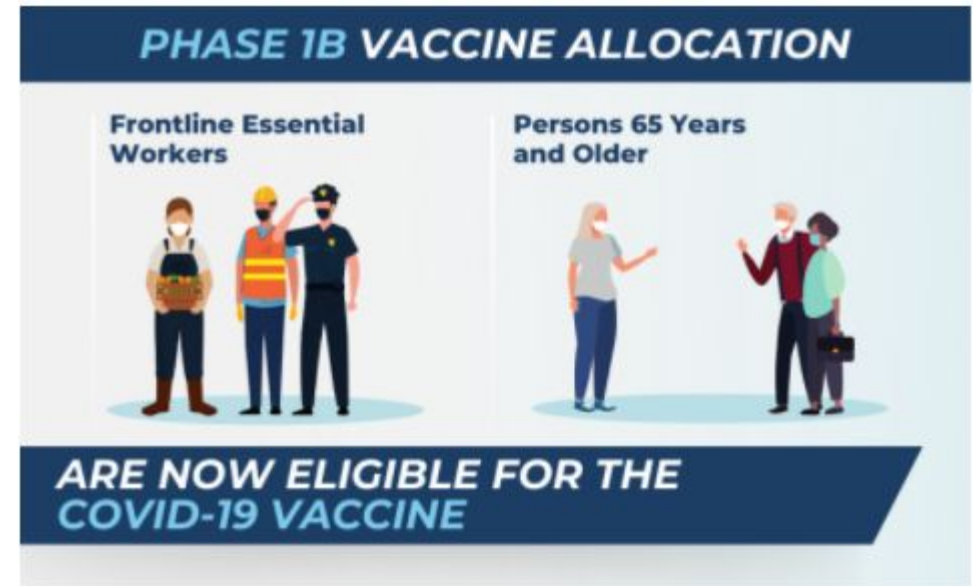


Vaccination Updates

Phase 1b (Current Phase)

- **Who:** Persons aged 65 and older, as well as those considered frontline essential workers including: police, fire, teachers, childcare providers, food processing workers, correctional officers and postal service, public transit and grocery workers will begin to be vaccinated.
- **When:** Now

Delaware Department of Education COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics: Limited supply of vaccine being provided to the State of Delaware weekly. All events will be dependent on vaccine supply.



Vaccination Updates

Phase 1b (Current Phase)

Steps:

1. School employee pre-registers with Delaware Department of Education (DDOE) and self identifies as stage 1, 2, or 3
2. Invites are currently being sent from DDOE for those educators identified as group 1. Latest round of invites was this morning.
3. When email is received from DDOE, school employee selects appointment time. Must provide proof of 1B eligibility at vaccination site.
4. Assistance - delaware.department.of.education@doe.k12.de.us and Vaccine@delaware.gov

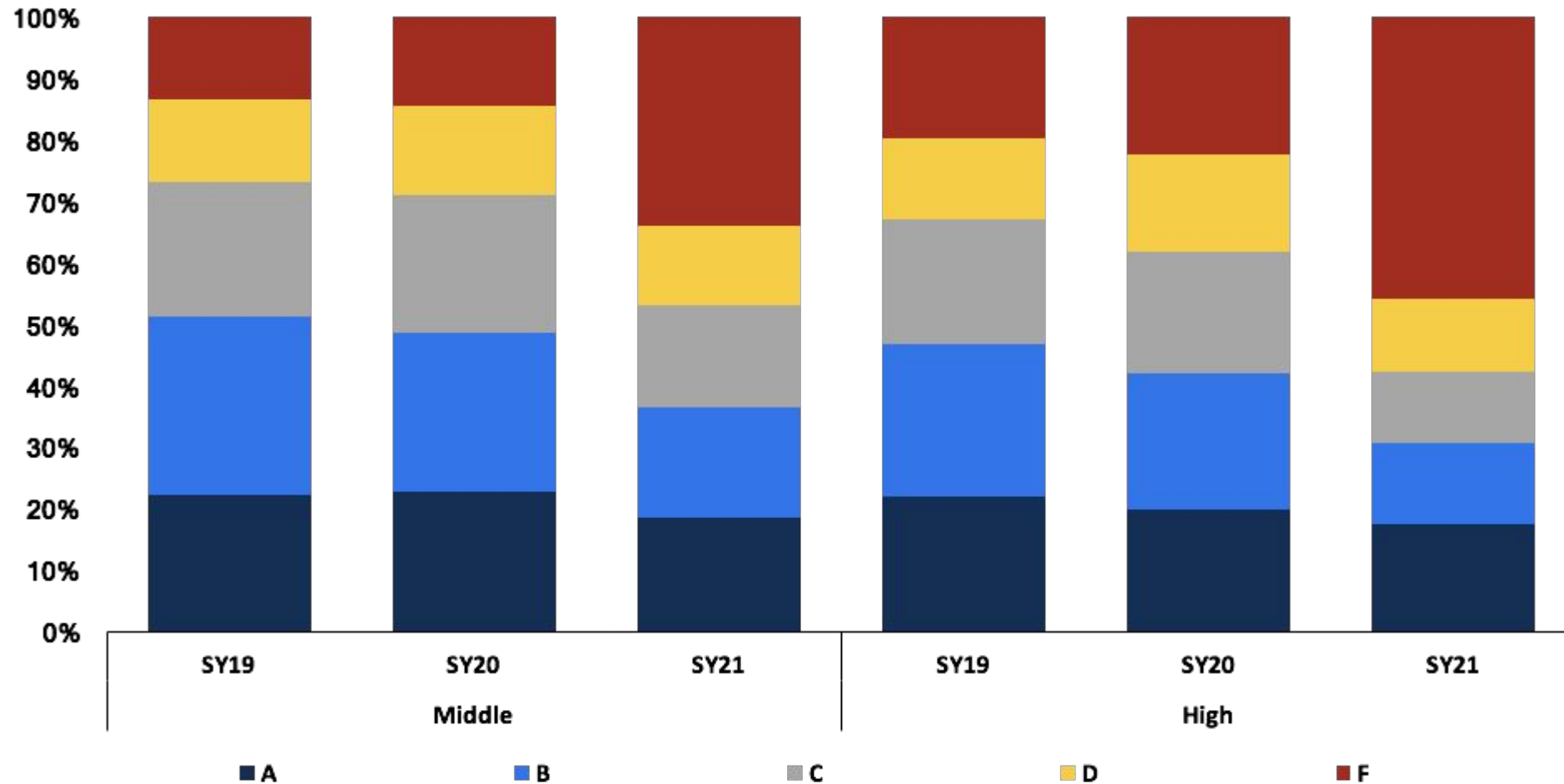

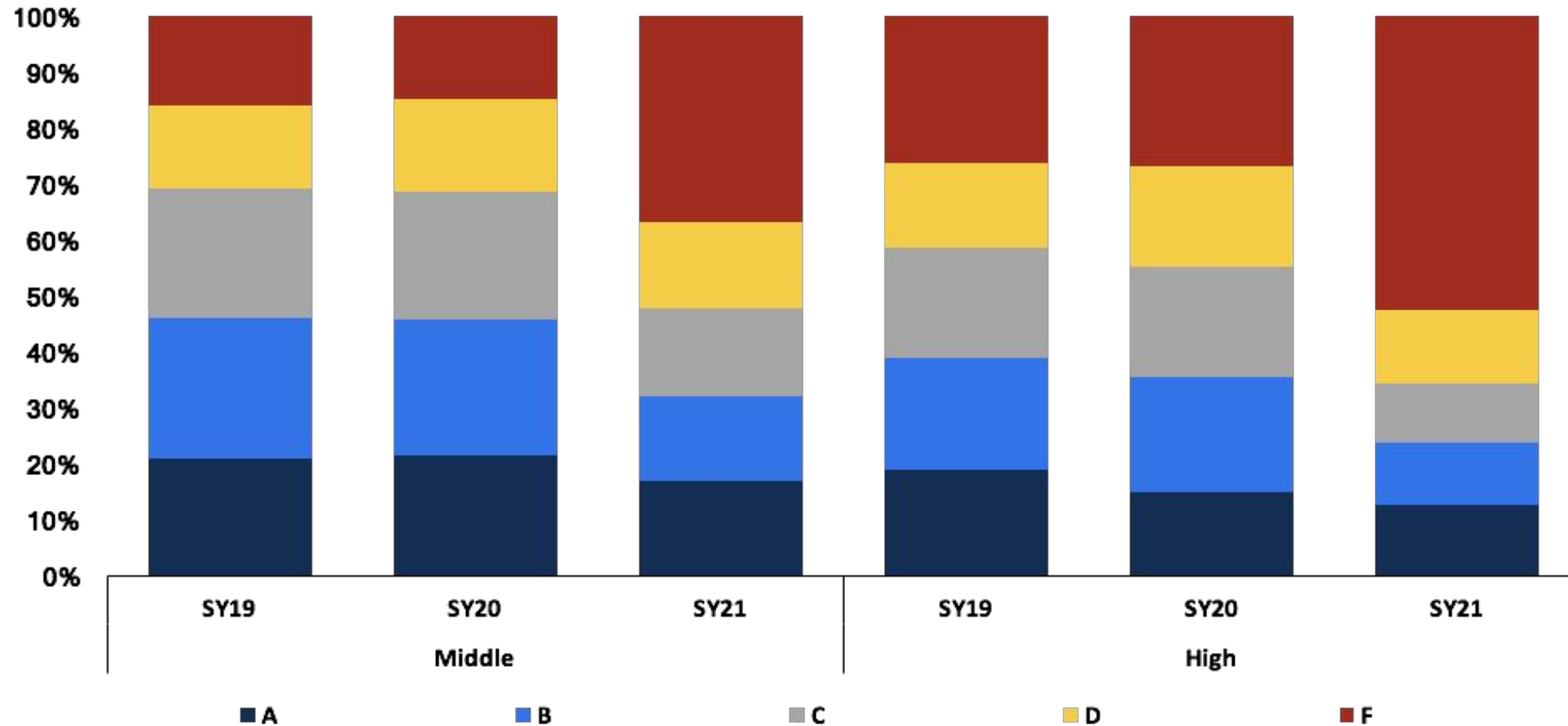
Secondary Grading Data

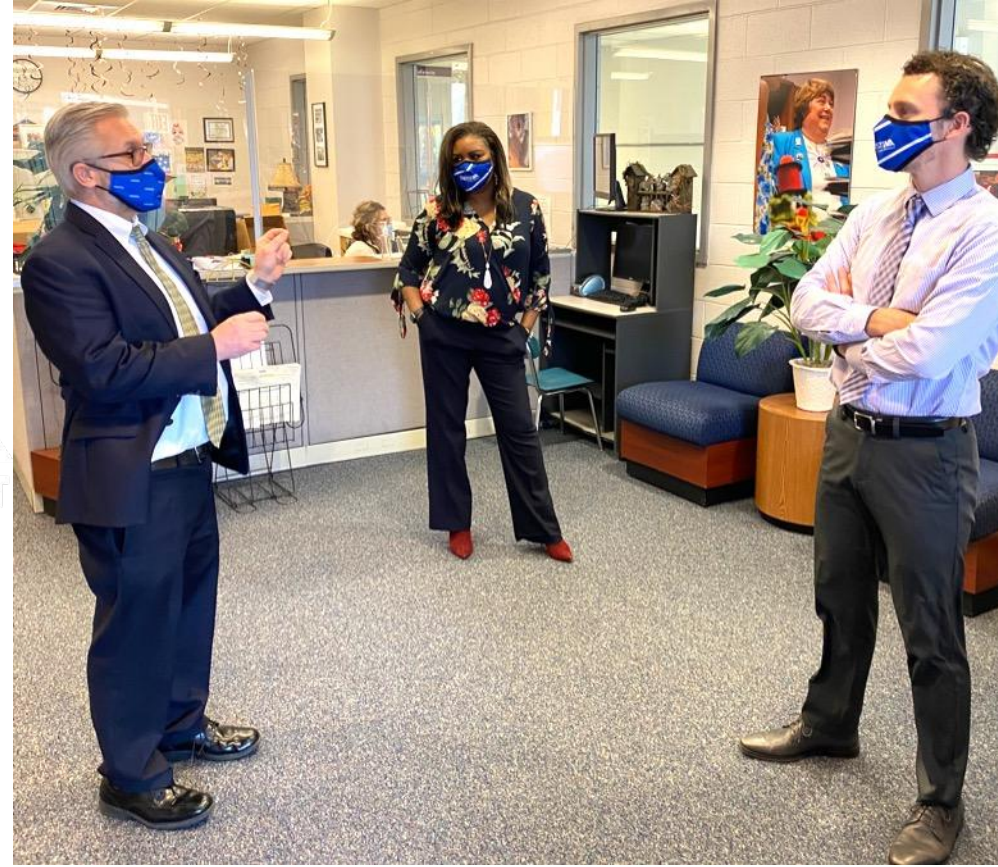

- Continue meeting with the New Castle County Public School Districts in conjunction with DPH and DDoE, to discuss any updates, share processes, and troubleshoot as needed
